

YUWO Scholarship Application 2024-2025

The Yale University Women's Organization ("YUWO") offers one-year Scholarships to women associated with the Yale community, whose formal education has been interrupted or delayed, and who wish to resume their academic studies or enhance their careers. Current and past scholarship recipients may reapply for one additional year. An applicant's Yale association may be through her own affiliation (past or present) or that of her immediate family. Immediate family is defined as spouse, parent, child, or sibling. *Current members of YUWO and their families are not eligible*.

Applicants are judged on merit and need. The scholarship award may be used only for unmet financial need or course tuition and academic fees only. The award is paid directly to the institution attended.

YUWO encourages all eligible women to apply. Submit the completed application form and all supporting material by emailing a PDF of all documents to <u>scholarships@yuwowomen.org</u>. The application deadline is March 31, 2024.

<u>Applicants will be informed of the Scholarship Committee's decision by April 30, 2024</u>. Awards will be presented at the YUWO Annual Meeting Luncheon in May 2024. We encourage Scholarship awardees to attend the annual meeting luncheon, but attendance is not required to be awarded a YUWO Scholarship.

In addition to the completed application form, a complete application includes the following materials:

- 1. A one-page statement outlining your projected education plans. Include (a) reasons you desire further study and career/educational goals, (b) the challenges that delayed or interrupted your education, (c) a brief statement about the program or courses that you will take, and (d) how this award will affect your plans. Include any other relevant information that you feel may uniquely qualify you for this scholarship.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation, preferably from your work supervisor and an advisor or professor at your current academic institution. If not currently enrolled or employed, you may submit letters from a supervisor of your volunteer work, a leader of your faith-based or community organization, or other non-related individual who has supervised your work. Letters must by typed and signed on letterhead stationery. Send as a PDF directly from the recommender's email to scholarships@yuwowomen.org.

- 3. A copy of your academic transcript if you are currently enrolled.
- 4. Attach a clear copy of your Yale ID or other documentation of your Yale affiliation. Submit a JPEG or PDF of your Yale ID or other verifying documentation. Contact scholarships@yuwowomen.org with any questions.

2023-2024 YUWO Scholarship Recipients Reapplying for 2024-2025

In addition to the completed application form, a complete application includes the following materials:

- 1. An essay describing your progress toward achieving your goals and your academic plans for the 2024-2025 year.
- 2. One letter of recommendation, preferably from a professor or program supervisor at your current academic institution. Letters must by typed and signed on letterhead stationery. The recommender is to send a PDF directly from their email to scholarships@yuwowomen.org.
- 3. A copy of your most recent academic transcript.
- 4. Attach a clear copy of your Yale ID or other documentation of your Yale affiliation. Submit a JPEG or PDF of your Yale ID or other verifying documentation. Contact scholarships@yuwowomen.org with any questions.

For All Applicants

The completed application and all supporting documentation must be received no later than March 31, 2024.

The application is incomplete if missing any of the required supporting documentation and will not be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to confirm that all application materials have been received when due. To inquire, contact <u>scholarships@yuwowomen.org</u>.
