



## YUWO Scholarship Application 2026-2027

The Yale University Women's Organization ("YUWO") offers one-year Scholarships to women associated with the Yale community, whose formal education has been interrupted or delayed, and who wish to resume their academic studies or enhance their careers. Current and past scholarship recipients may reapply for one additional year. An applicant's Yale association may be through her own affiliation (past or present) or that of her immediate family. Immediate family is defined as spouse, parent, child, or sibling. YUWO members and their families are ineligible.

Applicants are judged on merit and need. The scholarship award is for tuition cost only. The award is paid directly to the institution attended.

YUWO encourages all eligible women to apply. When the applicant has completed all application documents, please email [scholarships@yuwowomen.org](mailto:scholarships@yuwowomen.org) to request a unique link to upload all documents in PDF format to our Google Drive Folder. The application deadline is March 31, 2026.

Applicants will be informed of the Scholarship Committee's decision by April 30, 2026. Awards will be presented at the YUWO Annual Meeting Luncheon in May 2026. We encourage Scholarship awardees to attend, but attendance is not required to be awarded a YUWO Scholarship.

  - b. Provide a statement about your program and course of study.
  - c. Describe your career goals and motivation for pursuing further education.
3. Two letters of recommendation, preferably from your work supervisor and an advisor or professor at your current academic institution. If not currently enrolled or employed, you may submit letters from a former professor, a supervisor of your volunteer work, a leader of your faith-based or community organization, or other non-related individual who has supervised your work. Letters must be typed and signed on letterhead stationery and sent as a PDF directly from the recommender's email to [scholarships@yuwowomen.org](mailto:scholarships@yuwowomen.org).
4. A copy of your academic transcript if you are currently enrolled.
5. A JPEG or PDF of your Yale ID or other verifying documentation.

2. An essay describing your progress toward achieving your goals and your academic plans for the 2026-2027 year.
3. One letter of recommendation from a professor or program supervisor at your current academic institution. The letter must be typed and signed on letterhead stationery. The recommender is to send a PDF directly from their email to [scholarships@yuwowomen.org](mailto:scholarships@yuwowomen.org).
4. A copy of your most recent academic transcript.

**For All Applicants**

The completed application and all supporting documentation must be received no later than March 31, 2026.

The application is incomplete if missing any of the required supporting documentation and will not be considered.
