

The Yale University Women's Organization (YUWO), a 501(c)(3) organization, is made up of volunteers led by a Board of Governors composed of elected and appointed officers. Each officer is eligible to serve two terms of two years each.

The Board sets policy and meets bi-monthly, with five operating committees (Finance, Communications, Scholarship, Education, Membership Outreach) meeting on alternate months or as needed. Board meetings are open to all members and minutes are available.

Members are encouraged to play an active role in YUWO's governance and programming. Participation in YUWO committees is open to all, and volunteers are always welcome!
